

CODE OF CONDUCT "Professionalism, Integrity, Impartiality"

1. AS MINURSO PERSONNEL WE WILL ALWAYS:

- Conduct ourselves in a professional, disciplined manner;
- Dedicate ourselves to achieving the UN's goals;
- Respect local customs, practices and religious traditions;
- Treat local inhabitants with dignity, courtesy and consideration;
- Act with impartiality, integrity, and prudence;
- Observe the chain of command and comply with instructions related to our official duties;
- Respect our colleagues regardless of status, rank, ethnicity, nationality, religion, gender, or sexual orientation;
- Maintain dress and behavior befitting of UN personnel; and
- Responsibly account and care for all UN equipment placed in our charge.

2. WE WILL NEVER:

- Bring discredit upon MINURSO through improper personal conduct, failure to perform our duties or abuse our positions as UN personnel, including misuse of duty-free privileges;
- Abuse alcohol, use or traffic in drugs;
- Disclose information to unauthorized persons, or entities, including unofficial press statements;
- Seek or accept instructions in regard to the performance of our duties from any Government or other authority external to the UN;
- Commit any act of physical assault, verbal or sexual harassment or become involved in sexual relations which could damage the reputation of MINURSO;
- Willfully damage or misuse any MINURSO property or equipment;
- Use an official vehicle improperly, including speeding or other driving infractions, or transport unauthorized personnel;
- Participate in any illegal activities, corrupt or improper practices; or
- Attempt to use our positions for personal advantage, to make false claims or accept benefits to which we are not entitled.
- 3. WE REALIZE THAT THE CONSEQUENCES OF THE FAILURE TO ACT WITHIN THESE GUIDELINES MAY:
- Erode confidence and trust in MINURSO and the UN;
- Jeopardize the mandate of the Mission; and
- Endanger our status and security as UN personnel.
